Professor Kate Leslie

"To sleep, perchance to dream
– what's really happening during general anaesthesia?"

Professor Kate Leslie is a specialist anaesthetist and head of anaesthesia research at the Royal Melbourne Hospital. She is the chair of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (ANZCA) Clinical Trials Network and a member of the ANZCA Research Committee and ANZCA Foundation Board of Governors.

Kate has done extensive research in awareness and dreaming during anaesthesia and sedation.

She is currently a chief investigator of a large trial looking at the effects of light and deep general anaesthesia on older patients having major surgery. Kate is a former president of ANZCA, a former chair of the Committee of Presidents of Medical Colleges and a recent recipient of the ANZCA Robert Orton Medal and the Australian Medical Association Woman in Medicine award.
